



# SURVEILLANCE MEASURES/PREVENTION OF COVID-19 AND GUIDELINES FOR STUDENTS (PRIMARY & SECONDARY)



## COMMUTING

- Between home and school, parents must ensure students avoid visiting places that may result in a higher risk of spreading COVID-19.
- Parents must pick up students to go home before 17:00.
- Have a record of travel (Timeline) at school every morning (homeroom class).

## SCREENING

- Submit ATK test results to the school by Google Form every Sunday.

- When entering school, the temperature must be checked and hands cleaned with alcohol gel.

- Do the TST assessment (Thai Save Thai application - it is a risk assessment tool). Students have to do it every Monday, Wednesday, and Friday.



## STUDENTS' DAILY PRACTICE

- Students are required to wear masks at all times in school and have spare masks available. In the event that the mask is damaged, dispose of it only in the designated container.

- Have school supplies ready. Borrowing from others is not allowed.

- Prepare your own water bottle.

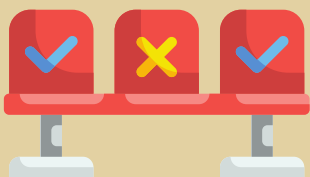
- Wash your hands: before eating, after activities, after going to the bathroom, and before entering every class.

- Prepare your own cleaning cloths for cleaning personal items.

- Keep a distance of 1 - 2 meters.

- Study, do activities, and eat according to the specified place only.

- No playing of team sports.



# SURVEILLANCE MEASURES/PREVENTION OF COVID-19 AND GUIDELINES FOR TEACHING, TEACHERS, AND STAFF (PRIMARY & SECONDARY)

## Teaching



- Organize no more than 25 students in normal-sized classrooms (6 x 8 m) and space them out. The distance between students in the room is not less than 1 - 1.5 meters.
- Organize activities together in the form of a Small Bubble, not cross-group activities with other classes.
- Schedule access to the library and laboratories for specific groups.
- Educate students on how to keep themselves safe.



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## Teachers and Staff

- All teachers and staff must be vaccinated.
- Avoid visiting places that may result in a higher risk of spreading COVID-19.
- Keep a record of travel (Timeline) every day.
- Submit ATK test results to the school by Google Form every Sunday.
- When entering school, the temperature must be checked and hands cleaned with alcohol gel.
- Do the TST assessment (Thai Save Thai application - it is a risk assessment tool). All teachers/staff have to do it every Monday, Wednesday, and Friday.
- All are required to wear masks at all times in school and have spare masks available. In the event that the mask is damaged, dispose of it only in the designated container.
- Keep a distance of 1 - 2 meters.
- Prepare your own water bottle.
- Wash your hands: before eating, after activities, after going to the bathroom, and before entering every class.
- Only eating at the specified places.
- Avoiding close group activities of more than 4 people (e.g., eating together).



# SURVEILLANCE MEASURES/PREVENTION OF COVID-19 AND GUIDELINES FOR THE SCHOOL AREA (PRIMARY & SECONDARY)

## Screening Zone

- Set up two screening points, D1 entrance, and D4 entrance, to have temperature measurements and clean your hands with alcohol gel.

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## Quarantine Zone

- Set up a school isolation room to be used as a quarantine and observation point for students, teachers, and staff.

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## Safety Zone

Clean all classrooms, laboratories, offices, and canteen to be sterile areas to make sure they are safe for students, teachers, and staff to perform activities and work safely.

### 1) Indoor air ventilation

- Opening doors/windows for ventilation in the morning, breaks, lunch breaks, and when there is no teaching. Schedule the time to be on/off for air conditioners and clean them regularly.

### 2) Cleaning

- Sanitize and disinfect tables, chairs, and classroom equipment every day after school.
- Clean and disinfect surfaces, touch devices, bathrooms, doorknobs, remote controls, handrails, light switches, elevator push buttons, drinking water points, etc. with 70% alcohol at least twice a day.
- Spray disinfectant in every room twice a month.
- Hand sanitizer gel service in every classroom, laboratory, and various screening points.
- More hand washing services (Other than 11 services at toilets) with posters on how to wash your hands.

### 3) Water quality for consumption

- Have a water quality examination for color, odor, and no impurities once a month.
- Maintain cleanliness of drinking water service points and daily drinking water containers (sharing a glass of water is strictly prohibited).

### 4) Nutrition

- Serve food for students, teachers, and staff under sanitary standards (food and nutrition).
- Prepare lunch and snacks in the form of box sets to reduce sharing from containers.
- Setting seating positions in the canteen and keeping distance.

### 5) Waste management

- Provide trash cans with lids. Collect garbage for proper disposal and good waste management.
- Waste segregation to reduce the amount of waste according to the 3 Rs (Reduce, Reuse, Recycle).
- Added a separate point of disposal for used masks.

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## Third Party (Outsider)

- When entering school, the temperature must be checked and hands cleaned with alcohol gel.
- Not allowed to enter the Safety Zone (inside the fence) without an ATK check.
- Wear a mask at all times in the school.
- Scan the Thai Chana application.

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## School Bus Service

- Make a plastic partition between the driver and the students.
- Check the temperature and clean hands with alcohol gel every time when getting on the school bus.
- Clean and spray disinfectant every time after sending students both in the morning and in the evening.





# **SURVEILLANCE MEASURES/PREVENTION OF COVID-19 AND GUIDELINES RESPONSE PLAN (PRIMARY & SECONDARY)**

*If students, teachers, or staff have a temperature of 37.5 degrees Celsius or higher and have respiratory symptoms:*

## *No history of high risk*

- Call the parent to pick up the student to see a doctor and have a COVID-19 test.  
Stay at home on the advice of a doctor.

## *When symptoms occur during the day*

- Separated to stay in the school isolation room. Call the parent to pick up.
- The school gives an ATK test kit for self-examination at home to report the results to the Thai homeroom teacher.
- The school nurse will follow up about student's symptoms:
  - \* **No infection** - Treated under the advice of a doctor and have a medical certificate before returning to school.
  - \* **Have infection** - Treated under hospital procedures.
- Close people have to quarantine for 14 days.
- Spray disinfectant in that room.
- Close the classroom according to the resolution of the school board meeting.

*Has a history of high risk in the 14 days before symptoms or close friends/family members who have been diagnosed with the virus*

- Separated to stay in the school isolation room. Call the parent to pick up.
- The school gives an ATK test kit for self-examination at home and confirmed with RT-PCR results.
- Inform the Public Health Center 21 Wat That Thong to assess the situation according to the disease investigation criteria.
  - \* **No infection** - Self-quarantine for 14 days. Show results and a medical certificate before returning to school.
- Spray disinfectant in the classroom.
- Others return to school or work as usual.
- The school nurse will follow up about student's symptoms.
  - \* **Have infection** - Follow school procedures.
- Close people have to quarantine for 14 days.
- Spray disinfectant in that room.
- Close the classroom according to the resolution of the school board meeting.

## *Covid Response Plan to prevent outbreaks in Bangkok schools*

### **1. Class/school closed:**

- \* **Found a patient or confirmed cases. Classes are closed for 3 days.**
  - Refrain from group activities.
  - High-risk people are quarantined at home. Low-risk people come to school as usual by observing the symptoms.
- \* **Found more than 1 classroom confirmed case. Classes are closed for 3 days.**
  - Refrain from all group activities and close the school.
  - High-risk people tested by RT-PCR.

### **2. Not closing the school:**

- \* **No confirmed cases were found in the school but there is a risk of infection coming from a home or community.**
  - High-risk exposure from home: observe symptoms for 14 days - if abnormal symptoms are found, please see a doctor for diagnosis, and stay at home.
  - Low-risk exposure from home: people close to others who may have had exposure to COVID-19 have to observe symptoms for 14 days. The student can come to school as normal.
